This will be the Projected Images program. Please submit your digital images via Email to both Paul DeRocker and Will Murray as we have done for the past two years. Deadline for digital image submission is midnight Saturday night, September 6th.

Note: If you have your images to present for competition in 35mm film slide format you will need to get them to either Paul or Will ASAP. The regular deadline would be one week earlier

than that for the digital images, or August 30th. But since many of us will be gone to the PSA National Convention in Portland, Oregon, please get your 35mm slides to Paul or Will by Sunday, September 7th. We will get them scanned and they will be included as digital images with the other digital images.

Dues are due! Act now if you plan to enter images for the September competition.
