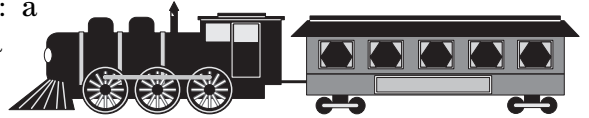

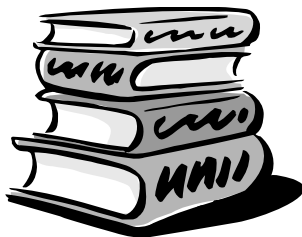

## Book Review

The World's Best & Easiest Photography Book  
By Jerry Hughes

I really enjoyed this little book. Mr. Hughes uses over 380 "how to" photographs and 125 sketches with captions to illustrate his ideas on how to take great photographs with any camera. He uses a system he devised – C.A.L.L. (Composition, Angle, Lighting and Lens) which he claims simplifies photography to its four basic fundamentals. Using these precepts one should be able to take great photographs with any camera of any subject in any situation. All the illustrations are in black and white and many are lousy pictures to illustrate his point. The book is available through the Spokane Public Library system, 771 HUGHES.
