## Memorial Exhibit of Photos by R. Bruce Carrick on Display at Downtown Library

Spokane, WA — Spokane Public Library is pleased to have an exhibit of photographs by ex-Library Director R. Bruce Carrick in the Downtown Library Northwest History Room. Mr. Carrick passed away at the age of 95 on December 28, 2002. The memorial exhibit will be on display through March 8, 2003.

Mr. Carrick served as Director of the Spokane Public Library system from 1960 to 1973. Before that he served as the County Librarian for ten years at Spokane County Library District. During his tenure with Spokane Public Library Mr. Carrick facilitated and oversaw the move of the Main Library from the old Carnegie building at South 10 Cedar to its current location at West 906 Main. Under his leadership an Outreach department was started and the total book collection reached a record high of 400,000 volumes as reported in the 1969-70 Annual Report. He reached an agreement with the County to allow borrowing at County Libraries for City Library card holders and added a retirement home to the Bookmobile service in 1968—paving the way to the Library's current Outreach service to retirement homes throughout the City.

Mr. Carrick was an avid photographer and a member of the Spokane Camera Club for more than 40 years. He won a number of awards for his photographs. He served as a regional director for the Photographic Society of America (PSA) and was presented with a PSA service award in 1972. He also received a PSA Associateship in 1983 and Fellowship in 1989. Members of the Spokane Public Library staff fondly remember his holiday cards, which featured his photographs.

The photos are on loan from Mr. Carrick's daughters Sandra and Jennifer and the exhibit is made possible with help from the Friends of Spokane Public Library.

## Zone System workshop

A workshop is planned for Wednesday, March 26 at 7:00 p.m. in the Photography Building (11) at Spokane Falls Community College.

David Sams will present his view of the Zone System as it can be applied to averaging and spot reflected light meters, incident meters and adjustable cameras (not full automatic). The principles can be used with b&w or color, negative or positive film as well as digital cameras.

The main reason to study the Zone System is to help the photographer develop control over the basic processes and thereby develop the ability to visualize the final image before taking the picture.
