Ok you got a new Toy for Christmas and want to get the best results out of your Canon Printer. Then don't print from your Editing Software! That's right I have found the best results are using "Canon's Easy-Photo-Print Plus". <http://www.usa.canon.com/html/conCprTSIndex.jsp?app=download>

Some of what it can do:

- Print Exif tag information with image
- Red-Eye Correction
- Digital Face Smoothing
- Sets the driver for optimum quality based on your printer, paper size and paper type
- Print Layouts, 3.5" – 8x10 (or larger if printer supports it)
- Shows the rule of Thirds in Cropping Photos

So download this useful software! It's free. Note: It's 18 Megs. If you have dialup I would gladly burn a cd for you!
