Make plans for Interstate Fair

The Spokane Camera Club will again be sponsoring the photographic competition at this year's Spokane Interstate Fair. This is a large event and requires the assistance of many club members. Areas where assistance is needed include:

1. Booth hosts to staff the exhibit. Four volunteers are needed each day of the fair. The tour in the exhibit is a 6-hour shift, leaving time to visit the fair itself during the rest of the day. The fair runs from September 5 through 14. Passes to the fair are provided to these volunteers.
2. The club also presents slide shows each day of the fair. The slides are shown three times daily in the afternoon and evening. If you have a show that you could share with the folks that visit the fair, it would be greatly appreciated. Shows do not have to have fancy music; they can be just the pictures that you are the most proud of!
3. The judging of prints and slides requires four volunteers, and will take place the evening of August 22. The set-up of the exhibit at the fair takes place on September 4, the day before the fair opens and requires four volunteers.
4. And finally, taking down the exhibit on the evening of the last day of the fair requires six volunteers.
