October Workshop with Bob Rowan

The October workshop will be presented on Wednesday, October 22, 7:00 p.m. at Spokane Falls Community College's Photography Building. The program will be given by Bob Rowan, a world class photographer and videographer, who operates a high-tech studio at his home in Newport, WA. Rowan has produced several books, including "Old Glory and Friends", a 48-page softbound book with 124 photos in both color and black and white, documenting the American response after September 11. Rowan will be discussing documentary photography and photojournalism.

HOW TO LOOK AT EVERYTHING

By David Finn

This book, published by Harry N. Abrams, Inc, is more an artsy philosophical tome. It is available in the Spokane Public Library (770.11 Finn). The author has written several books, including *HOW TO LOOK AT PHOTOGRAPHS*, and in this book he suggests ways of developing an enriched way of seeing. He offers the reader his personal view of how to enjoy more fully the pleasures that make life truly worth living: beautiful sights, fascinating objects, and shared experiences and warm companionship. Mr. Finn, an accomplished photographer for over fifty years, has chosen many excellent photographs to illustrate his points.
