## Browne's Addition walking tour

There will be an all-day workshop on Saturday, September 28 with the Valley Camera Club. The day begins at 9 a.m. at the Museum of Arts and Culture, 2316 W. First Avenue. Each participant should bring their camera and a roll of C-41 process 35 mm film, either color or b&w negative. Three groups will be formed to walk and photograph in historic Browne's Addition. At 11 a.m. the exposed film will be collected for processing. The group will then view the exhibit *A World of Grace - The Photographs of Kristin Capp* at the museum. The photos on display highlight Capp's work with the Hutterites, a sect of German-speaking farmers who shy away from the traditions of modern America.

After lunch, the workshop will continue at Spokane Falls Community College where participants can choose advanced black and white techniques with Roger Hartman, digital darkroom with Ira Gardner, or printing in the color lab with David Sams.

The fee for the day is \$20.00.
