## Fair Notes

The Spokane Camera Club has completed its 37th year of sponsoring the photo competition at the Spokane Interstate Fair. The 2003 Spokane Interstate Fair photo competition featured one of the largest print displays in the history of the fair. The photo competition contained 275 prints and 77 slides. The display covered 333sf of wall and 9 racks. The judging, hanging of the display, and staffing of the display during the run of the fair, is only possible with the participation of many members of the club. In fact, over 30 members of club volunteered their assistance in these activities. Some of them served on more than one day and 7 of them also presented slide shows for the entertainment of fair visitors.
