Introducing the Spokane Camera Club

The Spokane Camera Club was organized in 1932. The club's membership is now at the highest level in its history. Members have the opportunity to share their photographic interests with others, to participate in field trips and workshops, to learn from monthly competitions and commentaries, and to earn recognition for their achievements in an annual salon.

Participants in the monthly competition can enter two photographs in any or all of these categories: monochrome prints, color prints, and digital projection. The digital projection competitions are held on the first Wednesday and print competitions on the third Wednesday of each month, September through April.

As a part of each competition evening, a professional

photographer, educator or artist is invited to comment on and assign a score for each member's competition entries. This is an excellent opportunity for photographers to learn how effectively their work communicates with an experienced viewer.

The mission of the Spokane Camera Club is to stimulate the active enjoyment of photography by our members and the public.

The annual salon is held on the last Saturday in April. Here the members may enter photographs from those which were entered in the monthly competitions. The pictures are judged by three professionals from outside the club. Ribbons are given in each of eleven categories and thirteen trophies are awarded for the best work of the year.

Visitors are always welcome at Spokane Camera Club meetings. If photography is your passion, come and learn more about how you can share it with others.

Spokane Camera Club Meeting Schedule

Subjects of the month for 2012-13

In each monthly competition, there is a subject which has been chosen by the members as a "Subject of the Month." This is done to encourage exploration of a wider range of photographic expression than the members might otherwise undertake. These assignments can stimulate more conscious study than subjects to which the photographer is naturally drawn. The purpose is to improve the photographer's skills of observation with all subjects. Those who enter at least one picture in the subject of the month earn extra points in the monthly competition.
